#### Big changes are coming for Minnesota small businesses

#### Is your business ready for the new retirement mandate?

Starting January 2026, employers with five or more employees who don't offer a qualified retirement plan will be required to participate in the state-run Minnesota Secure Choice Retirement Program.

- Participation is mandatory for employers with five or more employees who do not already offer a qualified retirement plan.

- The proposed initial contribution rate is 5%, with automatic 1% annual increases, up to a maximum of 8%. Employees will be able to increase or decrease contributions.
- Employers cannot contribute—the program is funded solely by employee deferrals.






