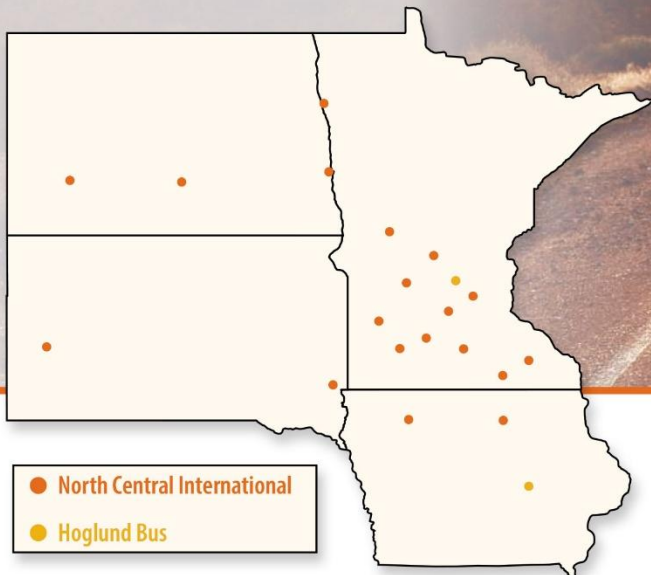

Big changes are coming for Minnesota small businesses

Is your business ready for the new retirement mandate?

Starting January 2026, employers with five or more employees who don't offer a qualified retirement plan will be required to participate in the state-run Minnesota Secure Choice Retirement Program.

Don't wait until the deadline—get ahead now by learning your options, understanding your responsibilities under the new law, and building a retirement plan that fits your business and supports your team.

Here's what you need to know

- Participation is mandatory for employers with five or more employees who do not already offer a qualified retirement plan.
- Employers are required to withhold contributions from employee paychecks and submit them to the state-run program. Employees may opt out of the program.
- The proposed initial contribution rate is 5%, with automatic 1% annual increases, up to a maximum of 8%. Employees will be able to increase or decrease contributions.
- Employers cannot contribute—the program is funded solely by employee deferrals.

With more than 48,000 Minnesota employers expected to be affected, taking action early can give your business a strong advantage.

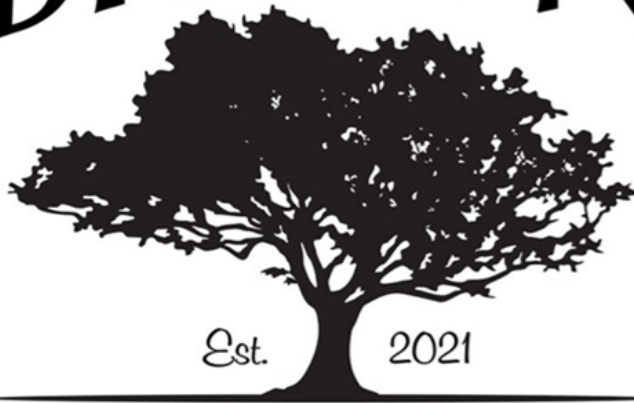
