

The SAFE (Springfield Area Food Emergency) program is a non-profit, emergency assistance program. It is funded through personal donations, local Foundations, other community non-profit entities and the (EFSP) Emergency Food and Shelter Program allocations.

The vouchers are distributed by pastors from each of the churches in Springfield as well as New Hope Lutheran and St. Paul's Catholic churches in Comfrey.

Vouchers can be used at Springfield Market or Mike's Discount Foods in Comfrey. Certain restrictions do apply. Individuals may receive up to four vouchers in a calendar year but no more than one voucher per month.

The SAFE program serves those from Springfield, Comfrey, Clements, Cobden, and Sanborn. It is open to all people regardless of age, gender, family status, race, denomination or religious background. The amount given per voucher depends on the number of people in the household. The program is confidential.





Brown County Historical Society Holds its 89th Annual Meeting

The Brown County Historical Society will hold its 89th Annual Meeting on Thursday, November 14, 2019 at Best Western Convention Center in New Ulm, MN. The night will begin with socializing at 5:30pm, followed by dinner at 6:15pm. The business meeting will begin at 7:15pm and the program will begin after the business meeting.

Guest speaker, Gary Clayton Anderson, is a professor of history at the University of Oklahoma at Norman, OK and known for his specialization in the area of American Indians of the Great Plains and Southwest. He is the author of books on the history of expansion of the west and the fate of the Native American populations that were affected by the settlement of land by European emigrants. His books include: Sitting Bull and the Paradox of Lakota Nationhood, Kinsman of Another Kind, The Indian Southwest, Little Crow Spokesman of the Sioux and Through Dakota Eyes.

His most recent book, *Massacre in Minnesota*, covers the Dakota War of 1862. Over 600 settlers lost their lives and thirty to forty thousand fled the frontier in Minnesota. More than 500 Native Americans perished in the aftermath of the war and 38 Dakota Warriors were hanged in Mankato in the largest mass hanging in North America. The book focuses on key figures caught up in the conflict – Indian, American and Franco and Anglo-Dakota.


