We are attempting to keep our volunteers safe. Many of the volunteers are vaccinated. We will do telephone orders if clients request and do curbside pick-ups. Client's numbers are going up and they do appreciate the new location and food that they can receive. Please continue to call ahead and let us know you are coming on a certain day (507-723-3663) Leave a message and we will call you back. Clients are happy to be able to come in again.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:

POPUK MEALS:

The food shelf has been helping with the popup meals event that is offered by LSS thru the summer months. They were held on the third Thursday in June, July, and last one will be August 19, 2021 from 12 noon-1:30 or until the meals are gone. This program is offered to any individual over 60 and is not income based. Meals are good and easy to fix. They go into the microwave and are ready to eat in 5 minutes.

BACKPACK FOOD PROGRAM FOR ELEMENTARY CHILDREN:

The food shelf will offer this program to kids in elementary. The paper work will be sent home with the school packets. If you are interested, please sign up for the program. Schools we are providing bags to is Springfield Public, St. Raphael's, and Comfrey school. The program is funded by private donations, foundations, and purchases from the local market/Second Harvest. We have very good support from the community and surrounding area. We can always use more donations to fund this program and it runs for the entire school year.

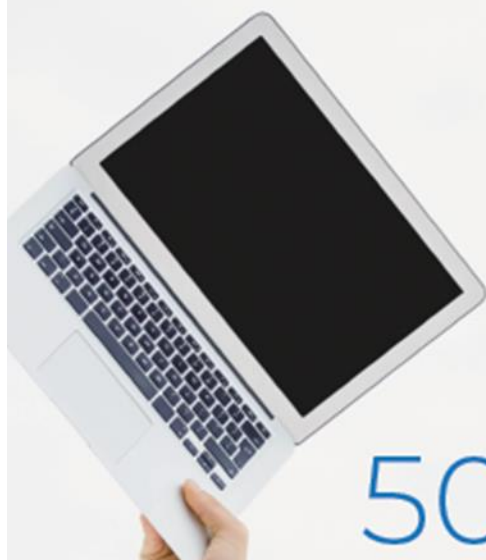
