

ONE YEAR LATER, SPRINGFIELD CLINIC THRIVING UNDER ALLINA HEALTH OWNERSHIP

In 2020, the New Ulm Medical Center (NUMC), part of Allina Health, took over ownership and supervision of the Springfield Clinic. Today the clinic is thriving and area residents are elated to have the vibrant facility as part of their community.

"We are thrilled that Allina is here," said Theresa Beckman, DC. Beckman was serving on the Springfield City Council when Mayo Clinic Health System announced they would be leaving the hospital and clinic in Springfield, and was involved in the decision to invite Allina Health to take ownership of the facility. When looking for an affiliate, Beckman said, the council found that almost 70 percent of their residents were already seeing a provider at Allina Health.

"The transition has been tremendous," Beckman said, noting that the month Allina Health took over the clinic in 2020 was the same month Minnesota Governor Tim Walz implemented a statewide shutdown, due to COVID. "Who would've thought a pandemic would happen at the same time? But the transition was seamless despite the pandemic."

Four Nurse Practitioners see patients full time at the Springfield and Lamberton Clinics: Valerie Folkens, Christie Vogel, Ashley Schmitt, and Joshua Hoffmann. Nurse Practitioner Kristina Carlson provides care to patients at area nursing homes. Annette Schmit-Cline, MD, an NUMC primary care physician, sees patients in Springfield once a week.

The Springfield Clinic offers many common services such as:

- Basic radiology services such as xray, mammography and EKG.
- Lab services
- INR (coumadin)
- Diabetes education and management
- Nutrition education with a dietitian
- · DOT physicals

Vogel and Beckman both highlighted the influx of specialty services as a key benefit to the new ownership.

"Since becoming part of the Allina system we have seen significant growth in our patient numbers. NUMC has supported us by increasing access to specialty care with onsite support in Springfield," Vogel said. "We have neurology, orthopedic surgery, general surgery, OB/GYN, telemedicine heart and psychology/psychiatry locally. This allows our patients to receive care locally and improves access to these

needed specialties."

"Neurology never used to come but they noticed there was a need so Allina has been fantastic in providing neurology services onsite," Beckman said. "The willingness to adapt has been amazing."

"NUMC has been incredibly supportive of the staff and providers here in Springfield during our transition to Allina," Vogel said. "The administration has worked hard to provide us what is needed to meet the needs of our patients. We feel supported as part of a team that enables us to deliver the best possible care to our patients."

The view from NUMC leadership is one of equal admiration.

"This team is so dedicated and so high functioning, it has been my privilege to watch them work together and support this community," said NUMC President Toby Freier. "When you walk into the Springfield Clinic, you get a feeling as if they've been a team for ten years instead of one. They are willing to do early anything to provide for their

community."

Freier said the quality of care at the facility is phenomenal. "They are a high-performing team. Their patient satisfaction scores are off the charts, showing the high degree of trust that patients have in the providers and staff," Freier said. "Their quality indicators in areas such as diabetes, blood pressure, and cardiac screening show that they are one of the leaders in the system for this patient population."

Community engagement is also gearing

up, Freier said. The team has hosted Free Bikes 4 Kidz (FB4K), and a women's health event, with more events and activities being considered as public gatherings become safe again.

The dedication from the Springfield team, supported by and integrated with Allina Health, makes the whole system stronger, Freier said. Vogel agrees.

"When you live in rural America, access to quality healthcare can be challenging, and nationally, rural residents face disparities in health outcomes. Springfield Clinic, along with the support of NUMC, provides residents of this area quality healthcare and access to specialty services locally to provide the best possible care and outcomes to our patients we serve," Vogel said. "We are honored to be here to serve our communities and be part of this robust healthcare system."



SouthPoint Financial Credit Union wins Member Service Award

(Sleepy Eye, MN – August 16, 2021) – SouthPoint Financial Credit Union has been honored with an award by Minnesota Credit Union Network (MnCUN).

The credit union is a recipient of a 2021 Louise Herring Philosophy-in-Action Member Service Award.

The Louise Herring award recognizes credit unions that demonstrate in an extraordinary way the practical application of the movement's principles in serving their members. SouthPoint was honored for their Community Advisory Committee (CAC) inception. The CAC was formed with the idea in mind that as SouthPoint grows and evolves, the organization recognizes that an important part of its mission is to hear and serve the members of communities served, while building for inclusion in expanding marketing to meet member needs when strategically possible. The committee meets quarterly with an advisory group within SouthPoint. Each meeting consists of an internal SouthPoint team providing an update to the CAC on products and services the credit union offers, along with updates within each of the SouthPoint's seven branch communities. The CAC members share their ideas and provide feedback that is beneficial for SouthPoint to know.

The award is named in honor of Louise Herring, an active supporter, organizer, and champion of credit union unions. She was the Ohio delegate at the 1934 national credit union conference in Estes Park, Colorado, where she signed the original constitution for a national credit union association. Herring believed that credit union should work in a practical manner to better people's lives. She saw the credit union as more than just a financial institution. In her own words, "the purpose of the credit union is to reform the financial system, so that everyone can have his place in the sun."

SouthPoint's Louise Herring winning entry will advance to the national competition, where it will compete with financial education projects from credit unions in other states.

SouthPoint Financial Credit Union is a not-for-profit financial cooperative that distributes profits among members in the form of lower loan rates, fewer and lower fees and higher savings rates.
