





The Springfield Area food shelf has been in the new location since March and it has been working very nicely. We are open on Tuesday nights 5-7pm and Thursday mornings from 9:30-11:30am. Clients are coming back in to the food shelf to do shopping with assistance. Clients need to mask as well as volunteers on service days. If you don't want to wear a mask then you can call order in and pick it up curbside. We are providing clients with meats, produce, grains, baking products, fruits and vegetables, dairy products, staple items. We have started to purchase fresh bread, buns on a regular basis from Springfield Market and some produce products such as Bananas, grapes, peaches when available.

Springfield Market provides products to the food shelf two times a week thru a program called Food Rescue. This is a very beneficial as we can pick up some bakery items and produce, dairy products.

Back Pack food program has started this year again. We currently have 30 bags that will go out weekly to St. Raphael's, Springfield Public School, and Comfrey school. The program is offered to elementary students. VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED TO PUT THE BAGS TOGETHER AND WE NEED INDIVIDUALS TO TAKE FINISHED BAGS TO THE SCHOOLS IN SPRINGFIELD. Putting the bags together can be done in the evening or afternoon on a non-service day. This counts for the required service hours that the kids need for school or religion. Call and leave message on the food shelf phone if able to help us (507-723-3663). NAPS which is a program for seniors is offered and boxes in Springfield are delivered to the home. This program is for people over 60. They receive a box of food items and a block of bonguard cheese. This is an income- based program and we can assist you with this program.


Holiday meals will be offered for Thanksgiving and Christmas. We did receive a grant from the Springfield Area Foundation to assist with the cost to provide this to our clients.

Volunteers are always needed to work in many areas. Please contact us if you are interested in doing something for your local food shelf. This is a wonderful program that we are able to offer to Springfield, Comfrey, Sanborn, Cobden, and Clements

> Brown County Historical Society Exhibit: 150 Years of the New Ulm Fire Department, 1870-2020

The public is invited to visit the Brown County Museum at 2 North Broadway Street in New Ulm to see the exhibit 150 Years of the New Ulm Fire Department, 1870-2020 before it closes on October 30.

For over 150 years, the New Ulm Fire Department has served the city of New Ulm and surrounding area. The department formed in 1870 after a serious fire demonstrated the need for organized fire fighters to protect the city. In the early days of the department, then called the New Ulm Fire Company, the firefighters were only called to fight fires. The fire company reorganized in 1887, becoming the New Ulm Fire Department. Since then, the department has professionalized, though is still voluntary, and provides a variety of other services in addition to fighting fires.

The *150 Years of the New Ulm Fire Department* exhibit outlines the history of the New Ulm Fire Department from its origins and early equipment, such as the "Mankiller" hand pump and early buckets, to its present status as a provider of fire protection, prevention, and rescue services. Displayed in the exhibit are equipment and uniforms from the New Ulm Fire Department – including a "bucket brigade" bucket and uniform from the 1870s. Also displayed are pictures of the department's equipment, and major fires they fought.

This exhibit will be on display through October 30, 2021 on the second floor of the Brown County Museum. For more information, please contact the BCHS at 507-233-2621 or education@browncountyhistory.mn.
