Medicare Wellness Visits

What are Medicare preventive services?

Medicare preventive services are special services for Medicare patients, included in your Medicare Part B insurance benefits. Prevention is an important part of staying healthy, so take advantage of these valuable opportunities to talk with your health care provider about your wellness, once every 12 months.

Welcome to Medicare visit

one-time service, within your first 12 months of Medicare Part B coverage

First annual wellness visit

one-time service, at least 11 full months after your Welcome to Medicare visit, if this was done

\checkmark

Annual wellness visit

ongoing annual visits, at least 11 full months after your last wellness exam

During your Welcome to Medicare and wellness visits, your provider may discuss the following:

- complete medical and family health history
- current medications and supplements
- height, weight, blood pressure and pulse
- immunizations
- screening for certain common conditions
- personalized screening plan for other conditions
- safety and accident prevention.


*Please bring all your medications to your appointment.

Your provider will perform an exam specific to your health care needs. Please be aware that these visits do not include an annual physical exam or treatment for other medical conditions.

Important information about your Welcome and wellness visits:

- Additional time should be scheduled if you plan to discuss new or existing health concerns. This can usually be done during the same appointment.
- Any additional medical services provided during your appointment will be billed separately to Medicare. Coinsurance and/or deductibles may apply to these additional charges.
- Your Medicare benefits do not include annual physical exams; however, Medicare does provide coverage for a breast/pelvic exam every other year.







