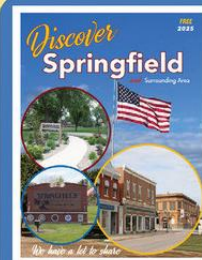

2025 Fox 9 TOWN BALL TOUR

Fox 9 Town Ball Tour to Spotlight Springfield

The Fox 9 Town Ball Tour is making a highly anticipated stop in Springfield on Wednesday, July 9, promising a day of baseball, community pride, and live television coverage at Riverside Park. Residents are encouraged to show their town pride by wearing Springfield baseball and softball jerseys and apparel throughout the day.

All the festivities at Riverside Park will begin in the afternoon. A coach pitch game is scheduled from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM, followed by a 7th-8th grade youth game from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. For musical entertainment, old time music will be featured on the plaza at the ballpark starting at 4:30 PM.

A variety of food options will be available. The Springfield Softball Association will be selling taco in a bag and mac & cheese cups. The Springfield Baseball Association's concession stand will offer a full menu, including burgers, fries, onion rings, and cheese curds. Additionally, MN Nice Cream will be providing free ice cream from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM.

Other attractions at the park include a pop-up shop by SotaStick selling Town Ball Tour merchandise and expert glove repair services from D&J Glove Repair. In addition to some early morning spots, Fox 9 will be conducting live news segments at various times beginning at 5:15 PM.

The evening will lead up to the main event: a Tomahawk East League game between the Gibbon Reds and the Springfield Tigers at 7:30 PM. Pre-game ceremonies will feature kids 10 and under running onto the field with the players for the starting lineup and anthem. The American Legion color guard will present the colors for the National Anthem, to be played by former SHS band director and Springfield Tiger ball player, Stephen Seaberg. The ceremonial first pitch will be thrown by Steve "Davis" Helget, the Springfield Baseball Association president and manager of the Springfield Tigers.

During the game, beer will be sold by Stunt Monkey, aka Jeff Lang, an on-air personality from Radio Mankato. There will also be several giveaways, including a total of \$400 in Springfield Chamber Bucks, sponsored by the Springfield Baseball Association and the Springfield Chamber of Commerce. Two Vikings tickets, donated by Rock Street Tavern, and two Twins tickets, donated by the Scheitel family, will also be given away.

The celebration will continue post-game with kids having the opportunity to run the bases and receive free frozen treats!

Don't miss out on a memorable day of fun, food, and baseball. Come on out to Riverside Park to support your local teams and show the Fox 9 crew some Springfield hospitality. See you at the ballpark!

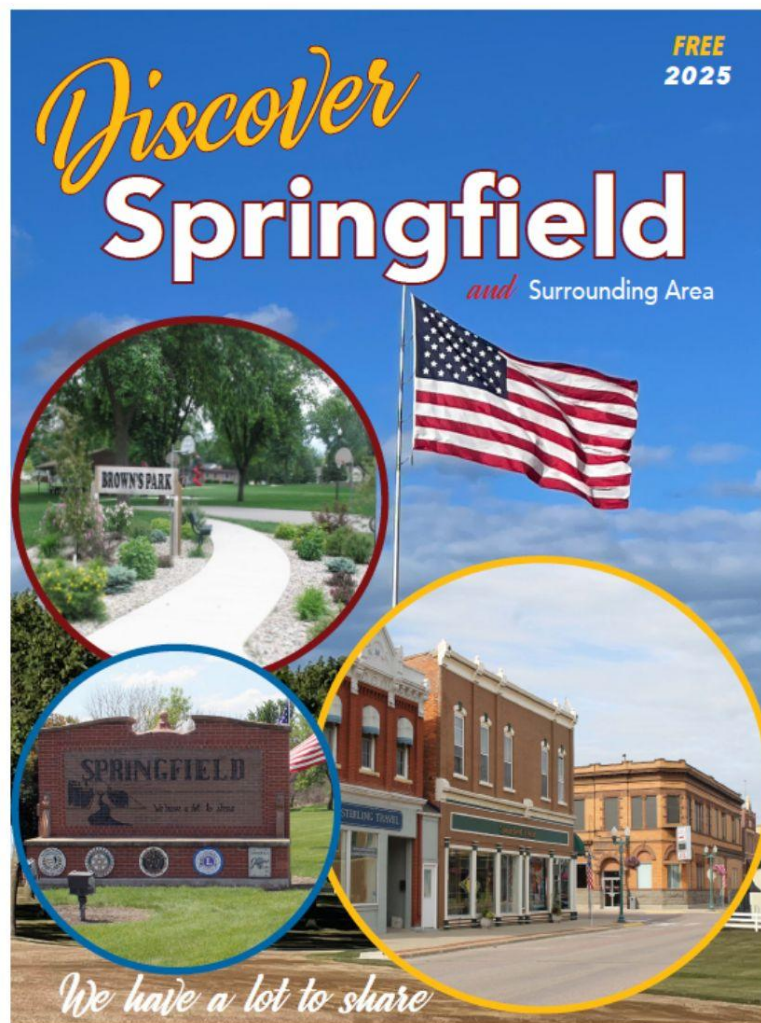
